PE Grant Funding

Summary of whole-school impact of the 2017/18 action plan (to date):

- 6/6 Year groups have had at least 1 half term of CPD alongside a specialist coach.
- 2/6 Year groups have had 2 half terms of CPD alongside a specialist coach.
- 100% of teachers have had CPD with Sport Co-ordinator in an area of PE they had self-identified as 'area for development' from skills audit.
- Allocation of PE Specialist in KS1 (SMc) had led to 6 extra-curricular clubs taking place in the school year so far. An increase of 2 since spring term 2017.
- KS1 hosted an active PE morning to introduce all children & train all staff how to use new equipment. The first of its kind to raise standard in PE.
- 37 different teams have represented the Academy so far this school year maintaining the schools position since Spring 17.
- 20 different extra-curricular clubs have taken place so far this school year increase of 3 clubs since spring term 2017.

KS2 Extra-Curricular PARTICIPATION:

101/123 boys participate - 30% increase since autumn 2016.

79/117 girls participate in extracurricular activity - 4% increase since autumn 2016.

17/28 Pupil Premium participate in extracurricular activity.

18% increase overall in extra-curricular participation since autumn 2016.

25/54 boys participates in extra-curricular activity.

22/67 girls participates in extra-curricular activity.

SWIMMING:

49 / 60 (82%) of pupils in Year 6 can swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres, use a range of strokes effectively and perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations.
