



RE: Classroom ventilation and cold weather

Dear parents and carers,

As you may be aware, the government guidance states that classrooms should be well ventilated to reduce the potential spread of the virus. As part of our risk assessment, we have classroom windows and doors open throughout the day to ensure a constant flow of fresh air. As the weather becomes increasingly colder, we are aware that the children may need to wear additional layers of clothing inside the building. The classrooms, although permanently heated, will be cooler than normal in the winter months.

In the first instance we would like to ensure that all children wear their school jumper daily. On particularly cold days, extra layers such as a base layer of thermals, vest, and/or an extra t- shirt could also be worn. We will continue to monitor this and make further amendments to our uniform policy if it is needed to ensure our children are comfortable.

As ever, we ask that all items of clothing are clearly named.
