



Learning Launchpad: Spring 1, 2020-21

There's lots of things to look forward to and we can't wait to get started.

Key Learning

English: In English we will be focussing on the text 'Sam's Sandwich' where we will be writing our own instructions on how to make a disgusting sandwich (urgh). We will be applying our phonic knowledge, using coordinating conjunctions to join sentences together, learning how to make plurals and using noun phrases to make our writing exciting.

We will also look at the book 'Rocket Says Look Up!' to create our own flyer about an exciting event which will be happening in school. We will be learning about verbs, question marks and exclamation marks as well as learning how to use the prefix un.

Maths: In Maths we will continue to learn about place value within 20 and learning all about tens and ones. We will also be learning how to add by counting on, subtract by counting back.

DT: In DT we will be creating hand puppets. We will think carefully about our design- which fabric to use and why- and looking at different joining techniques.

Geography: In Geography we will be learning about the four countries of the United Kingdom, their capital cities and surrounding seas. We will also be brushing up on our map skills by learning how to locate these on a map. During the topic, we will be taking a tour of each country and learning about the different human and physical features.

Computing: In Computing, we will be learning about the main parts of a computer, what the internet is, how to use the internet and we will be brushing up on our typing skills.

RE: In RE we will be learning about what it means to belong to a church or a mosque. We will be learning about groups we belong to, places which are special to us and why churches and mosques are special to Christians and Muslims.
