


Learning Launchpad: Spring 2, 2021

We hope that you have had a great half term and we are looking forward to starting some new and exciting topics!

Key 'learning and doing' + useful links . . .

English: In English, we will be focussing on the text called 'The Secret of Black Rock' where we will be writing our own diary entry from Erin of what happened. We will be applying our phonic knowledge to sequence sentences to form a short narrative, which will include being able to spell the days of the week. We will also focus on spelling words ending in -ing and how to use the personal pronoun I.

Maths: In Maths we will continue to learn about Place Value across 50. We will count, read, and write numbers to 50, be able to identify 1 more and 1 less and we will also learn to count in multiples of 2, 5 and 10.

D&T: In D&T we will be creating a book with a slider and a pop up. We will think carefully about our design and evaluate our finished product.

PSHCE: In PSHCE we will be looking at 'What money is' and how make people make choices about what to do with money including spending and saving.

Science: In Science, we will be learning all about Plants and animals. We will be naming and identifying fish, mammals, amphibians, reptiles, and birds. We will be able to describe the structure of common flowering plants and trees.

Art: We will be looking at paper weaving and textiles.
