To Parents of children at our KS1 site,

On Thursday 6th May, our site will be used as a polling station for the local elections. We are pleased that we are able to keep school open on this day with some minor adjustments to keep everyone safe.

For the drop off in the morning, please can we ask that all children are left at the gate to come down into the playground as we are not able to operate our usual one- way system due to the car park being in use for voters. This means our Reception children will need to come down on their own, but do not worry as their teachers will be on hand to help and will prepare them beforehand.

At the end of school, please come at your usual time to collect your child from the playground before going back up the path that you use to enter the playground. For children in Year 2, you will need to go round the back of the building to collect from the door at the end of the path that runs across the top of the field and then leave the site the same way you came in. Again, we will have staff available to show you the way.

As always, we ask that all parents wear a face covering unless they are exempt and that you stick to the 2m social distancing rule.
