



## Key Learning

**English:** In English we will be focussing on Roald Dahl's 'The Twits.' We will be writing to entertain, and the children will write their own chapter. We will be concentrating on making our writing interesting for the reader by including extended noun phrases to add detail. We will be writing for different purposes including writing to inform. Where the children will write instructions of how to complete a trick, using the correct layout and bullet points.

We will continue to work on our phase 5 phonics sounds, including alternative pronunciations and continue to spell common exception words. We will continue to practice and develop our cursive Greetland handwriting.

**Maths:** In Maths we will be looking at Position and Direction to describe position, direction, and movement, including whole, half, quarter and three-quarter turns. Then we will focus on Number and Place Value (within 100). Learn measurement through money, to recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes. To measure through time, to compare, describe and solve practical problems. To sequence events in chronological order using language. To recognise and use language relating to dates and years. Learn to tell the time to the hour and half past the hour and draw the hands on a clock face to show these times.

**History:** In History we will be looking at the Enquiry question: Who was Mary Anning and why is she remembered? With a focus on; why are some people famous when they are alive? Why are some people famous after they die?

**Science:** In Science we will be completing a STEM Unit called 'Holidays.' The children will learn about describing the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials and compare and group them.
