Phonics:


We begin to 'Grow the Code' in phonics: learning that the same sound (phoneme) can be represented by different letters (graphemes). The table below covers the different alternatives we will be learning this half term. We will continue to post a review video at the end of each week on Seesaw.

English:



Our key texts for this half term are 'Pumpkin Soup' and 'There's No Big Bad Wolf In This Story'. We will use these to write for 2 different purposes: to inform & to entertain. The writing emphasis will be on the application of phonics when spelling and the basic skills of capital letters, full stops and finger spaces to ensure they are embedded.



Maths:

The importance of early number and early understanding of mathematics cannot be underestimated. We are ensuring the children are secure in the basics, particularly around place value and the introduction to the concept of parts and wholes. We will continue to interpreting mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs. This half term will also cover: greater than/less than symbols (<, >), ordinal numbers (1st, 2nd, 3rd ...), number line problems, part-whole models, fact families, finding the difference and comparing addition and subtraction statements ($a + b > c + d$). Each area of maths is rich in language and ensures children can apply the skills through reasoning and problem solving.
