

Dear Parents,

We would just like to take this opportunity to remind you that Thursday 7th July will be our Sports Day for all pupils at KS1.

The events are scheduled to take place as follows:

Reception	1.30-2.00pm
Y1	2.00-2.30pm
Y2	2.30-3.00pm

After the events, children will return to the classroom and be dismissed at the usual time of 3:15pm. All children will be dismissed from their usual doors.

As we are unable to plan for all weather eventualities, could we please ask you to ensure that your child has sun screen applied before they come to school and has a hat in case of hot weather. Your child should also have their water bottle with them. All pupils will be required to be in school P.E. kit, including appropriate outdoor footwear, but may wear their red PE hoodie or red school jumper if the weather is cold. Please can we remind you that all hair must be tied back and earrings removed.

In the case of extreme weather, a decision will be made the day before as to the postponement of the event. I'm sure you will all appreciate that this is a difficult decision, however it is made with safeguarding as our main priority.

At KS1, please enter the premises through the drive gate, across the carpark and onto the field via the wooden gate located outside Year 2. This will be the only entry and exit point (not the school office). The gate will be opened at 13:15pm for parents to arrive. This year, in line with safeguarding procedures, all parents will be required to sign in and out of the event and will need a sticker on at all times. A sign in table next to the wooden gate at the entrance to the field, will be set up and will be manned for the duration of the event. Can we ask that all parents do not enter the school building unless accompanied by a member of staff.

As always you are more than welcome to come along and support your children. Could we please take this opportunity to remind you that dogs are not permitted anywhere within school grounds with the exception of guide dogs. We hope to see you then for what should be another great event and I'm sure you will join us all in praying for good weather.
