Welcome back to school! We hope that you have had a wonderful summer holiday. This half-term, we are excited about all the new learning that will be happening in Year 2. The children will have opportunities to develop their writing skills, using their phonic knowledge, to support their spelling across a range of writing styles.

Maths: In Maths, this half term, we will be focusing on number and place value. This will involve us looking at the place value of 2 digit numbers, counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 and recognising odd and even numbers. We will then use place value and number facts to help us solve problems

Science: Why can't we just eat chocolate?

Geography: Are all areas of the world the same?

**PSHCE:** What helps us grow and stay healthy?

**RE:** How is new life welcomed?

**DT:** Pouches - Learn how to sew a running stitch ready to design, make and decorate a pouch using a template.
