## Welcome back!

Welcome back to another half term at school! The busy one with lots of fun Christmas activities to look forward to! The children need to get their Christmas jumpers ready and we will be supporting Overgate Hospice with the Reindeer Run again. **English:** This half term we are going to focus on the text 'Cloud Busting'. This is a book written in poetic form all about a special friendship. We will then look at 'Cloud Busting' again but this time with a different purpose; writing to inform. The children will produce their own information text all about bullying.

Maths: In Maths we will continue looking at 'Addition and Subtraction'. We will continue looking at column addition and subtraction as a written method and add and subtract up to four-digit numbers. Once we are confident with this skill we will start to apply it to solving complex two-step problems.
