I Can Reach Great Heights!

Reception will continue with our over-arching theme of 'I can reach great heights.' This term we will be exploring and celebrating difference. We will be finding out about different people and their jobs as well as learning that we can all have high ambitions and aspirations. The concept of resilience will play a big part of this theme; developing the understanding that if we encounter a problem, we will need to keep trying to overcome difficulties. These are just some of our key texts for the half term...



English: Children will continue to apply their knowledge of Little Wandle Letters and Sounds with increasing accuracy and independence. Although there are no new sounds to learn next half term, we will be reviewing all of the Phase 3 digraphs and trigraphs that we learnt in Spring 1 and begin to apply these sounds to our writing with increased independence. We will also begin to learn how to read longer words ending in -s, -es and -ing.

Maths: We will continue to use subitising skills to explore and deeply understand the composition of numbers within 10. We will be finding more or less than a given number, both practically and using a visual representation. We will be playing games and completing practical activities to develop counting and estimation. Children will continue to solve simple practical addition, subtraction & division problems while broadening their under-
