Learning Launchpad: Spring 2, 2023 YEAR 5 Miss Hanson and Mr O'Shea





Welcome back!

Welcome back after a lovely half term holiday! We hope you all had an enjoyable rest and are ready to go again! This half term, we have got lots of exciting things planned: one of them being a Viking Experience Day, where visitors will come into school and deliver a range of exciting activities! We also have the Year 5 Easter Service, at St Thomas' church to look forward to! It's great that we are able to do these things again!

English: In English, we will be focusing all of our learning around the book "Holes" by Louis Sachar. We will be focusing on spelling, punctuation and grammar in our writing, improving our handwriting and ensuring we use cursive script. We will be writing to inform- We will create an information leaflet on an animal, producing a 'Deadly 60' style report. We will also focus on using different writing techniques including subheadings and bullet points to make our writing clearer to the reader.

Maths: In Maths this half term, we will be focusing on fractions, decimals and percentages. We will learn how to compare and order fractions whose denominators are all multiples of the same number. We will then identify, name and write equivalent fractions of a given fraction, represented visually, including tenths and hundredths. We will then add and subtract fractions with the same denominator and denominators that are multiples of the same number. We will then multiply proper fractions and mixed numbers by whole numbers, supported by materials and diagrams. Finally, we will read and write decimal numbers as fractions and percentages e.g. 0.71 = 71/100.

History: Change and continuity/Cause and Conse-

quence: Why did the Vikings invade Britain and what did

they change?

PSHCE: What decisions can people make with money?

RE: Should we forgive others?
