Welcome back!

Welcome back to a new half term! We hope you all had a fantastic Easter and are now ready for the Summer term! Time does fly when you're having fun! In the Spring term, the children really impressed us with how much progress they made, their attitude and enthusiasm towards their learning was fantastic. We're sure it will continue! There's lots to learn to get the children ready for Year 4!

English: This half term we are going to continue our work on 'The Spiderwick Chronicles'. We will be building up to be able to write our own chapter from the story and will be focusing on the use of direct speech. We will then be writing to inform based on 'Arthur Spiderwick's Field Guide'. We will study a range of magical creatures from the field quide using our reading behaviours. Then we will look at different author techniques and apply them to our own writing. We will follow the writing process by planning, writing and editing our own field guide entry based on a magical creature that we created ourselves.

Maths: This half term we will consolidate our understanding of 'Time' and apply our knowledge to reasoning and problem solving questions. After that, we will be looking at 'Measurement'. We will start by looking at 'Length and Height' before moving on to 'Mass, Volume and Capacity. We will measure, compare, add and subtract different units of measurement and also measure the perimeter of simple 2D shapes.

Science: Our unit this half term is Light. Our enquiry question that we will be investigating is, 'How can we change the size of a shadow?'
