
Welcome back! The summer term is finally here. This term, we will be very busy bees planting in our Year One garden and extending our learning even further to get ready for Year 2! We have lots of exciting and ambitious learning planned.

Phonics:

The Children now understand that there are graphemes that can have different sounds and sounds that can be made with different letters. We will now work on the consolidation of these sounds. Additionally, we will focus on the sounds (see below) which will be appearing in the Phonics screening test at the beginning of June.

English: Our focus book will be Winnie The Pooh, we will use this traditional classic tale to inspire our writing. We will be writing to entertain; through predicting, story mapping, describing settings and characters. The emphasis once more will be to build on the basic skills of capital

letters, full stops and finger spaces. As well as applying all the alternative sounds and correctly spelling tricky words and using 'and' and 'because' as a coordinating conjunction.
