English: In English, this half term, we will be consolidating basic writing skills, including capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. Maths: In Maths, this half term, we will be focusing on number and place value. This will involve us looking at the place value of 2-digit numbers, counting in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 10 and recognising odd and even numbers. We will then use place value and number facts to help us solve problems.

Station - To understand how computers can help
