We've been so impressed with how the children have settled into life in Year Three and adapted to the new routines at Key Stage Two. We are certain they will continue in this enthusiastic manner as the year progresses. There's lots of things to look forward to this half term, especially all of the Christmas fun and we can't wait to get started!



English: This half term our writing will focus on the book 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes. Our purposes this half-term are to provoke an emotional response, e.g. making the reader feel scared or excited and to inform. We will be looking at how our choice of vocabulary suits the purpose of our writing and how best to capture and hold the attention of the reader. We will be applying the skills of using expanded noun phrases to add detail and description. Spelling will also continue to be a focus this half term.

Maths: In Maths we will continue looking at 'Addition and Subtraction'. We will begin the term by applying our knowledge to the inverse operation. When we are confident with this skill we will then apply it to solving complex two-step and missing number problems. Towards the end of the term, we will move on to our unit of 'Multiplication and Division'. Here we will focus on multiplying and dividing two-digit numbers by one-digit numbers.
