Welcome back!

Happy New Year! We hope you had a lovely Christmas break, enjoyed the festivities with your families and had a well-earned rest! We are really looking forward to starting the new year as we mean to go on. We are really excited about all of the new things that the children will be learning next term. We can't wait to get started! We will be having a big focus on ensuring that the children are confident in their understanding of reading comprehension and all aspects of our reading VIPERS.

English: In English, we will be focusing all of our learning around the book 'The Eye of the Wolf' by Daniel Pennac. We will be focusing on writing and recording an information text based on the wolf's physical attributes, habitat and lifestyle. In our second piece related to 'The Eye of the wolf', we will be focusing on how to discuss and share a balanced argument. We will continue to focus on expressive vocabulary, spellings and grammar within our writing.

Maths: In maths this half term, we will continue looking at multiplication and division. We will continue learning the formal written method for long multiplication for 2-digit by 2-digit. We will then apply this to different multiplication questions up to 4-digit by 2-digit, before looking at formal methods for division.
