English: This half term we will focus on 'The Spiderwick Chronicles' to inspire our writing when writing to provoke an emotional response. We will look at recounts; teaching the children the techniques used to write an effective diary. The children will apply this learning when writing a diary in the character of Jared Grace from The Spiderwick Chronicles. We will then be writing to inform based on 'Arthur Spiderwick's Field Guide'. We will study a range of magical creatures from the field guide using our reading behaviours. Then we will look at different author techniques and apply them to our own writing. We will follow the writing process by planning, writing and editing our own field guide entry based on a magical creature that we created ourselves.

Maths: We will begin this half term by looking at 'Measurement'. We will start by looking at 'Length and Height' before moving on to 'Mass, Volume and Capacity. We will measure, compare, add and sub-tract different units of measurement and also measure the perimeter of simple 2D shapes.

Computing- Programming; Sequencing Sounds DT - Cooking & Nutrition; Eating Seasonal French - Fruit and Vegetables Geography: Place-Based Study; Rio & South Brazil -Are all settlements the same? PE: Striking and Fielding PSHCE: Why should we keep active and sleep well? RE: What do the Creation Stories tell us? Science: Light; How can we change the size of a shadow?
