

Dear Parents,

We would just like to take this opportunity to remind you that Thursday 4<sup>th</sup> July will be our Sports Day for all pupils at KS1.

The events are scheduled to take place as follows:

Reception 1.30-2.00pm Υ1 2.00-2.30pm Y2 2.30-3.00pm

As we are unable to plan for all weather eventualities, could we please ask you to ensure that your child has sun screen applied before they come to school and has a hat in case of hot weather. Your child should also have their water bottle with them. All pupils will be required to be in school P.E. kit, including appropriate outdoor footwear, but may wear their red PE hoodie or red school jumper if the weather is cold. Please can we remind you that all hair must be tied back and earrings removed. In the case of extreme weather, a decision will be made the day before as to the postponement of the event. I'm sure you will all appreciate that this is a difficult decision, however it is made with safeguarding as our main priority.

This year, in line with safeguarding procedures, all parents will be required to wear a visitor sticker at all times. As Sports Day is on the same day as Polling Day, we politely ask that any spectators enter via the path down to the playground, rather than down the school driveway. Can we ask that all parents do not enter the school building unless accompanied by a member of staff. The main gate will be opened 15 minutes before each event begins for parents to arrive and will be manned for the duration of the event. This will be the only entry and exit point (not the school office).

As always you are more than welcome to come along and support your children. Could we please take this opportunity to remind you that dogs are not permitted anywhere within school grounds with the exception of guide dogs. We hope to see you then for what should be another great event and I'm sure you will join us all in praying for good weather.
