Curriculum Focus

English: This half term we are going to focus on the text 'Peter Pan'. First we will study the book using our reading behaviours, particularly focusing on visualising. We are going to analyse the techniques and the language that the author uses to support us in writing our own setting description. Then we are going to look at 'Peter Pan' in a different way with the purpose of writing to persuade, trying to persuade others to either be a pirate or a lost boy!

Maths: In maths we will be completing our work on addition and subtraction, then moving on to multiplication and division. We will be practicing our times tables up to 12x12 and counting in multiples of 6, 7 and 9. We will explore factor pairs and multiply and divide two and three-digit numbers by a one-digit number using a formal written layout.
