### **Curriculum Focus**

#### English:

PHONICS: This half term, term we will continue to learn more phase 5 and tricky words. Watch out for our weekly videos on seesaw, where you will be bale to see what sounds we have learnt each week. We will continue to focus on reading fluency and building recognition.

This half term we will be reading a range of different books including Zog and Goldilocks and he three crocodiles. We will be learning lots of high level vocabulary and applying these orally into our story telling. We will also be focusing on writing sentences using the sounds and tricky words that we have learnt in Reception and Year 1. We will continue to focus on letter formation and remembering capital letters and full stops.

**Maths:** The half term, we will be learning about mathematical statements involving addition (+), subtraction (-) and equals (=) signs. We will also cover, part-whole models, fact families, finding the difference and comparing addition and subtraction statements (a + b > c + d). We will then move on to place value numbers to 20.

DT: Moving story books
History: How am I making history?
Music: Dynamics and tempo
PE: Ball skills
PSHCE: Who is special to us?
RE: Why are festivals important in a community?
Science: Which of the 5 senses do you think are the most important?
