#### **Curriculum Focus**

We will be writing to provoke an emotional response and to inform. We will be writing diary extracts and a blog. We will also focus on using different writing techniques to make our writing clearer to the reader.

We will be looking at adding and subtracting whole numbers with more than 4 digits, by using formal written methods to help us. We will also be adding and subtracting numbers mentally with increasingly large numbers and using rounding to check answers to calculations.
