

Reception Curriculum Information



Maths: We will continue to use subitising skills to begin to explore and deeply understand the composition of numbers within 10. We will also begin to develop our counting skills; organising and counting larger sets of a wide range of objects. Children will be able to use counting skills in a range of contexts, including counting things that cannot be seen (for example, the number of times a ball is bounced) or using counting to measure time (for example, when playing hide and seek).

Curriculum Focus

Reception will begin the next over-arching theme of 'I can reach great heights.' We will be exploring and celebrating difference. We will be finding out about different people & jobs and learning that we can all have high ambitions and aspirations. The concept of resilience will play a big part of this theme; developing the understanding that if we encounter a problem, we will need to keep trying to overcome difficulties.
